OPENING THE MEETING - ROSS PLOURDE

Ross opened the meeting by greeting the new board members, Thurman Lynch, Jaena Poppe and Julia Walter.

CANCER TASK FORCE UPDATE - DREW NEVILLE & KATHY MCCRACKEN

Kathy mentioned that the Department of Pediatrics is in a holding pattern on hiring a new section chief due to the climate surrounding recruitment to OU Health. Dr. Kahn, interim section chief, needs to handle a few things internally and focus on a few internal processes before moving forward.

Drew gave a report on the status of the Drew Neville Charity Classic. To date, we have 16 celebrity/influencer/pro players on the list. We have 7 sponsorships, with a total commitment of \$235,000. Jeremiah, Drew and Thurman met with the club yesterday and Tom Jones was blown away by the amount of work CHF has poured into this and the success we are having. The tournament has a potential to net more than \$400,000-\$500,000 with teams, sponsorships, auction, and fund a need.

FINANCE REPORT- RANDY KAMP
